

TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM

The Ottawa County Safety Council, under the sponsorship of the Ottawa County Improvement Corporation, implemented the **TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM** in 2016. The purpose of the program is to provide funds to member businesses interested in providing additional, professional training opportunities to their employees.

The **TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM** will be available to fund training related to topics such as:

- HVAC
- Supervision
- Human Resources
- Confined Space
- Arc Flash
- Drug-Free Workplace

Other topics will be considered.



The **TRAINING GRANT PROGRAM** will reimburse the employer for instruction costs. *Other incidental costs can be submitted to the Council under the \$100 annual rebate program.*

Training can be conducted on-site by an outside vendor/trainer or employees can be sent off-site for the training.

The Safety Council will offer up to \$3,000 total in grants per program year to member businesses – up to \$1,000 per employer.

Grant applications will be reviewed and awarded on a first come, first serve basis.

Approved grants will be paid via reimbursement once an invoice is submitted.

Guidelines:

- Member businesses may only apply for one grant per year limit of \$1,000.00
- Applications must be submitted at least <u>two weeks in advance</u> of the training to be evaluated for eligibility
- Approved applications will be paid via reimbursement to the member once 1) a
 paid invoice has been submitted and 2) the training has been completed
- After eligibility is established, funding will be awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis
- Eligibility will be based on several factors including:
 - member status with the council
 - o training topic applicability
 - cost and value (number of employees benefiting from the training opportunity)
 - o quality or qualifications of training vendor and training content
- Funding may or may not be approved for the entire submitted cost; members will be notified of the amount awarded
- Once \$3,000 in grants have been awarded, additional applications will be considered for the following program year
- The Training Grant Program will be evaluated each year by the steering committee for renewal or discontinuation based on participation, interest and financial considerations
