WORKFORCE SIGNING DAY

- Workforce Signing Day was put together to recognize high school seniors who will be starting their career path in the workplace.
- 3 high school seniors from Danbury Local Schools signed their letters of intent to enter the workforce after graduation.
- 1 high school senior from Woodmore Local Schools will sign his work contract following graduation.

OTTAWA COUNTY REACH PROGRAM



- The REACH Program is designed to introduce elementary school students to the workforce by allowing business representatives to visit the students on a monthly basis.
 Two of the six school districts participated during the 2018/2019 school year.
- Participating businesses: Northern Manufacturing, OhioMeansJobs Ottawa County, Ottawa County Dept. of Job & Family Services, Commodore Perry Federal Credit Union, Davis Besse, Village of Genoa, Luckey Farmers, McDonalds(Genoa), GenoaBank and Luther Home of Mercy.

CEO INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

- The Career Engagement Opportunity (CEO) program is a credit-based internship program for seniors that launched in Ottawa County high schools for the 2017/2018 school year. To date, 36 students have completed the program.
- The CEO program is designed to give juniors and seniors the opportunity to work in a local business in the student's desired career field.
- This year, internships were held within the law enforcement, construction, education, sales and marketing, landscaping, healthcare and automotive industry sectors.



OTTAWA COUNTY CAREER SHOWCASE



Businesses included:

The Ottawa County Skilled Trades Academy and the Marine Apprenticeship Program were also featured at the event.

- Held on Friday, October 4, 2019 at the CMP Competition Center at Camp Perry, in conjunction with National Manufacturing Day.
- **497 students,** from 6 local high schools, engaged in career exploration activities with businesses in an effort to help students explore the skill sets necessary to obtain careers in Ottawa County.
- **35 businesses** were represented. (largest business participation since 2014)
- Businesses presented numerous engagement activities for students - donning/doffing PPE, Sheetrock plastering and molding activities, operating a backhoe, safety relays, athletic training and physical therapy challenges, team building exercises, and chemistry experiments top the list.



OTTAWA COUNTY SKILLED TRADES ACADEMY

- The Ottawa County Skilled Trades Academy is a comprehensive, credit-based skilled trades program for high school seniors. The OC STA was implemented in the 2019/2020 school year.
- Certified by the Manufacturing Skill Standards
 Council (MSSC) and teaches the MSSC Certified
 Production Technician (MSSC CPT) curriculum.
- Classroom instruction includes MSSC CPT curriculum and hands-on lab activities in the designated workshop area.







- 12 high school seniors from five of the 6 school districts are currently enrolled in the program.
- Activities include: tours of local businesses, such as C. Nelson Manufacturing and Davis Besse, and working on projects in the workshop that involve scaffolding and carpentry.
- Completed CPR Certification training.

OTTAWA COUNTY TEACHER MANUFACTURING BOOT CAMP



- Held June 10-13; **22 teachers and school counselors participated.**
- All participants toured manufacturing companies in the Ottawa County and created a culminating project to summarize their experience to use with students in their classrooms during the 2019/2020 school year.
- Participating businesses included: Northern Manufacturing, Zink Calls, USG, Davis Besse, The Chipmatic Company, Lakefront Marina, and Port Clinton Manufacturing.


OTTAWA COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FUNDING
